

CONTINUING POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR PROPERTY

THIS CONTINUING POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR PROPERTY is made by **Dried Jamal**, of the City of Mississauga, in the Regional Municipality of Peel and also of the community of High Prairie in the Province of Alberta.

APPOINTMENT

1. I APPOINT my parents, Emad Saleh and Nesreen Naser, jointly and severally to be my attorneys for property. If the person I have appointed, cannot or will not be my attorney because of refusal, resignation, death, mental incapacity or removal by the court, I SUBSTITUTE nobody. I authorize my attorney to do, on my behalf, any acts which I can do by an attorney, and specifically anything in respect of property that I could do if capable of managing property, subject to any conditions or restrictions contained in this Continuing Power of Attorney for Property.

POWER TO MANAGE PROPERTY

2. This document is a continuing power of attorney for property under the *Substitute Decisions Act, 1992*, S.O. 1992, c.30, as amended, and may be used during my incapacity to manage property.

EFFECTIVE DATE

3. This Continuing Power of Attorney comes into effect on the date it is signed and witnessed.

CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

4. The signature of either attorney is sufficient.

REVOCATIONS

5. I revoke any prior power of Continuing Power of Attorney for Property given by me, except any other continuing power of attorney for property made as at the date hereof.

MULTIPLE POWERS OF ATTORNEY

6. I retain the right to make multiple Continuing Powers of Attorney for Property.

DELEGATION


7. I authorize my attorney to delegate my attorney's authority to some other person and to revoke or suspend such delegation.

FAMILY LAW ACT CONSENT

8. I authorize my attorney named to exercise all of my rights with respect to the disposition, encumbrance or possession of a matrimonial home under the *Family Law Act*, R.S.O. 1990 c. F.3, whether or not my name appears on the title, including consenting to any disposition or encumbrance by spouse of any interest in our matrimonial home.
