- c) It is my intention and I so authorize my attorney(s) that this authority shall be exercised during any incapacity on my part to manage my property, pursuant to Sections 7 and 14 of the Substitute Decisions Act.

FAMILY LAW CONSENT

4. If my spouse disposes of or encumbers any interest in a matrimonial home in which I have a right to possession under Part II of the Family Law Act, I authorize the attorney(s) named in this power of attorney for me and in my name to consent to the transaction as provided for in clause 21(1)(a) of the said Act.

7. Any prior power of attorney for property or any power of attorney which affects my property previously given by me is hereby revoked.

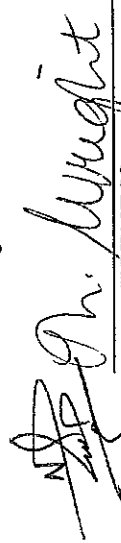
COMPENSATION
