## Hi Grahme,

I met with Paul Belanger from Belanger Engineering and property management to review the glass breakage vesterday at units 2801 and units 2203. In both cases I was unable to determine the cause of the breakage leading me to believe that the glass failed spontaneously with the aid of extremely cold temperatures and high winds. In both cases the railing structures were sound and solid with no obvious damage or installation issues.

Please see the attached detail that represents both units.

We had installers on site at the same time to remove the broken pieces of glass and make the balconies safe. The tenants were notified in both cases not to attempt to gain access to their balconies by property management.

Today we replaced the glass in unit 2801. Property Management needed to provide notice for unit 2203 and glass needs to be acquired for replacement. We are planning to replace glass at 2203 on Monday.
