### **FIREPLACES**

Fireplace Marble: Due to the many variables that can affect the pattern and/or design, frequently the marble installed on the fireplace will not be identical to the samples. We will make every attempt to come as close to the samples as possible, but cannot be responsible for results which differ from the samples.

### **CERAMIC FLOOR TILE**

Many variables including variegation can affect tile colour, pattern and/or design which mean installed tiles may not be identical to the samples. We will make every attempt to come as close as possible, but cannot be responsible for results which differ from the samples.

### **HARDWOOD FLOORING**

The purchaser is advised that cupping and shrinkage are characteristics of hardwood flooring normally appearing after installation, especially when humidity levels are not regulated, and no warranty is provided by the flooring supplier with respect to such cupping and shrinkage. Furthermore, hardwood floors may also heave and warp when located at or close to entrance points of the home, where rain could make its way to the flooring. ### **STAIRCASE VS FLOORING**

#### **WOOD SPECIES DIFFERENCE**

The purchaser is aware and therefore accepts and acknowledges that the wood species of the staircase and flooring chosen do not match. This difference might result in an undesirable colour variance.

The purchaser is aware and therefore accepts and acknowledges that though the flooring is of the same species as the staircase the difference in product finishing may result in a stain colour variance.

The purchaser agrees that the vendor is to be exempt from any and all claims by the purchaser regarding this colour variance.

### **RAILINGS**

All railings, pickets, posts, nosing's and stairs come from solid wood and veneered wood materials sourced from multiple locations and sources. As such there will be variations in grains and shades between the various natural components beyond our control. Due to this variance in material, all components will stain with colour or natural finish differently.

Iron pickets are wrought in nature and depending on the manufacturing process will have differences from picket to picket which is normal. Also the finish of the iron pickets is of a powder coated nature. This process can produce minor colour variations or tones. Furthermore, the assembly of the metal pickets can develop a natural rattle over time from vibration in the railing. Minor rattling is normal and is a part of the wrought iron picket assembly.

### **HOUSE EXTERIORS**

Variations in subcontractors across different sites and varying site conditions may result in house exteriors that differ from the artist renderings. We cannot be responsible for results which differ from the artists renderings of elevations.

### **PLASTER MOULDINGS AND MEDALLIONS**

Plaster mouldings will not be installed in open to above areas or areas with 2 storey elements.

### **STAIN COLOURS**

Due to the many variables that can affect the outcome of a stain colour on wood, staircases, railings, and fireplaces, the colour may not be identical to samples. Factors such as density, age, humidity, air temperature, and the uniqueness of each piece of wood can result in wide variations in darkness or lightness. Stain on pre-finished hardwood floors will not be an exact match to the stain colours available on stairs, pickets and rails. The purchaser is responsible for choosing the stain on these areas to their satisfaction.

### **IN-WALL CONDUIT FOR AUDIO/VIDEO CABLES**

It is important to note that due to the variation in framing requirements in different parts of your home, conduit lengths and routing can vary. In virtually all instances of ground floor installation (I.e. above a fireplace), conduit will first travel down into the basement below the floor joists, over to the termination point and back up into the main floor. As a result, it is best to measure the length of the conduit after occupancy with a "pull wire" before



To properly install your oven, you must determine the type of electrical connection you will be using and follow the instructions provided for it here.

- Oven must be connected to the proper electrical voltage and frequency as specified on the model/serial/rating plate. See the following illustration.



A. Model/serial/rating plate

- Models rated from 7.3 to 9.6 kW at 240 volts (5.4 to 7.4 kW at 208 volts) require a separate 40-amp circuit. Models rated at 4.8 kW and below at 240 volts (3.6 kW and below at 208 volts) require a separate 30-amp circuit.
- A circuit breaker is recommended.
- Connect directly to the fused disconnect (or circuit breaker box) through flexible, armored or nonmetallic sheathed, copper cable (with grounding wire). See "Make Electrical Connection" section.
- Flexible conduit from the oven should be connected directly to the junction box.
- Do not cut the conduit. The length of conduit provided is for serviceability of the oven.
- A UL listed or CSA approved conduit connector must be provided.
- If the house has aluminum wiring, follow the procedure below:
  1. Connect a section of solid copper wire to the pigtail leads.
  2. Connect the aluminum wiring to the added section of copper wire using special connectors and/or tools designed and UL listed for joining copper to aluminum.





Type of Gas

Natural Gas:

- This cooktop is factory set for use with Natural gas. If converting to LP gas, see the "LP Gas Conversion" instructions provided in the package containing literature. The model/serial rating plate located on the underside of the cooktop base has information on the types of gas that can be used. If the types of gas listed do not include the type of gas available, check with the local gas supplier.



- Electronic ignition systems operate within wide voltage limits, but proper grounding and polarity are necessary. Check that the outlet provides 120-volt power and is correctly grounded.






Typical In-line Blower Motor System Venting Installations









1. Remove grease filters from range hood. See the "Range Hood Care" section in the Use and Care Guide.
2. Install the motor support bracket using three 4.2 x 8 mm screws. Screw bracket to the inside top or back (alternate location on some models), toward the left side of the range hood.
3. Install motor spring clip using two 4.2 x 8 mm screws. Screw spring clip to the inside top or back (alternate location on some models) of the range hood at the proper location for the selected motor system. Slide the mounting tab of the spring clip through the slot in the panel and secure with the screws. Use the inside set of mounting holes for the single motor system. Use the outside set of mounting holes for the dual motor system.





#### Single Blower Motor Assembly




A. Wiring connection

#### Dual Blower Motor Assembly










A. Motor mounting plate
