- Install the washing machine on a solid floor that is strong and rigid enough to support the weight of the washing machine, even when fully loaded, without flexing or bouncing. If the floor has too much flex, you may need to reinforce it to make it more rigid. If the floor is not solid, it may cause severe vibration and noise.

- LG recommends the use of LG hoses. Any leaking, property damage, or damage to the washing machine caused by an improper installation or by the use of non-LG hoses is not covered under the terms of the LG warranty and is the sole responsibility of the installer and/or an installer.
- Water supply pressure must be between 20 psi and 120 psi (1.35-8.27 MPa). If the water supply pressure is more than 120 psi, a pressure-reducing valve must be installed.
- Inspect the threaded fitting on each hose and make sure there is a rubber seal in place in both ends of each hose.
- Connect the water supply hoses to the HOT and COLD water faucets supply by hand and then tighten another 2/3 turn with pliers.
- Always run a gallon or two of water through each inlet hose to flush dirt, scale and other debris out of the water lines. Doing so will help prevent future problems with clogged filter screens, and will also allow you to verify which water line is hot and which is cold.
- Attach the hot water wire to the hot water or water on the back of the washer. Attach the cold water line to the cold water inlet on the back of the washer. Tighten the wire as securely. Turn ON both faucets at the sink and check for leaks at both ends of the hoses.

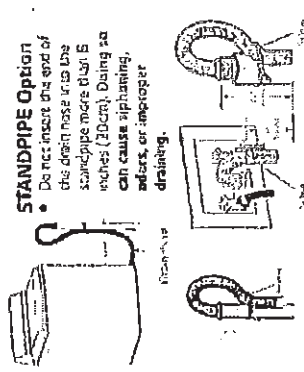


- The washer should be plugged into a 120-VAC, 60-Hz grounded 3-prong outlet. Plug in the washer, proper contact on the equipment-grounding conductor can result in risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or service technician if you are in doubt as to whether the appliance is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the appliance. If it does not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician. Failure to follow these warnings can cause serious injury, fire, electrical shock, or death.

- The power outlet must be within 60 inches (1.5 m) of either side of the washer.
- The appliance and outlet must be positioned so that the plug is easily accessible.
- Do not overload the outlet with more than one appliance.
- The outlet must be grounded in accordance with current wiring code and regulations.
- Time-delay fuse or circuit breaker is recommended.
- It is the personal responsibility and obligation of the product owner to have a certified electrician install the outlet.



- The drain hose should always be properly secured. Failure to properly secure the drain hose can result in flooding and property damage.
- The drain must be installed in accordance with any applicable local codes and regulations.
- Make sure that the drain hose is not stretched, pinched, crushed, or kinked.
- The maximum length of the end of the hose should be approximately 35'-4" (10.5 - 1.2 m) from the floor.
- Do not install the end of the drain hose lower than
 - 29 in (73.7 cm) or higher than 95 in (241.3 cm) above the bottom of the washer or more than 60 in (152.4 cm) away from the washer.
- Never create an airtight seal between the hose and the drain with tape or another means if no air gap is present. Water can be siphoned out of the tube resulting in poor washing performance or other damage.



- Do not use this drain hose with a floor drain. The end of the drain hose must be at least 25 inches above the floor for proper draining to occur.

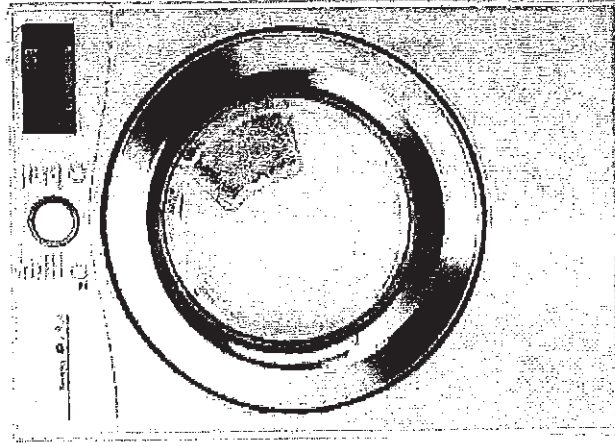

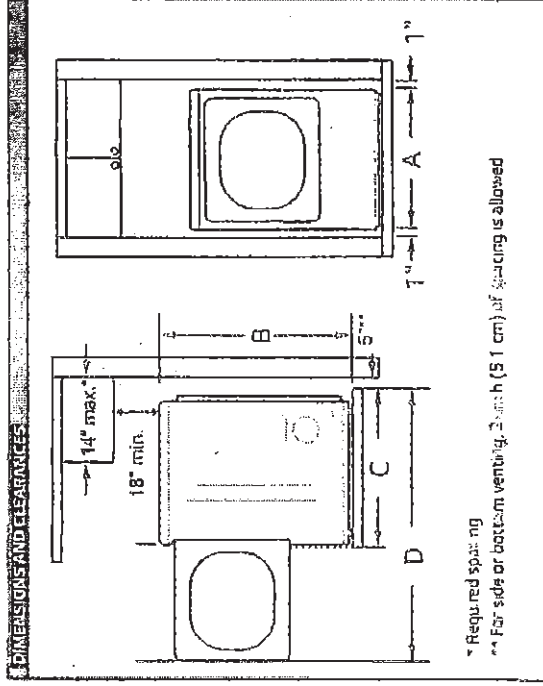

 - The dryer is configured for natural gas when shipped from the factory. Make sure that the dryer is equipped with the correct burner, orifice for the type of gas being used (natural gas or propane gas).

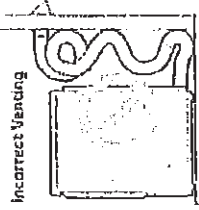
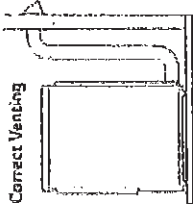
- **A 4-wire connection** is required for all mobile and manufactured home installations, as well as **all new construction after January 1, 1996.**
- **A 3-wire connection is NOT permitted for new construction after January 1, 1996.**
- **All listed strain relief is required.**
- **Use a 30-amp, 240-volt, 4-wire, UL-listed power cord with a 10 AWG minimum copper conductor and double loop at marked terminals with upturned ends.**



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NOTE: Follow the guidelines below to maximize drying performance and reduce loss, buildup, and condensation in the ductwork. Ductwork and fittings are NOT included and must be purchased separately.

- Use 4-inch (10.2 cm) diameter rigid, semi-rigid or flexible metal ductwork.
- The exhaust duct run should be as short as possible.
- Use as few elbow joints as possible.
- The male end of each section of exhaust duct must point away from the dryer.
- Use duct tape on all duct joints.
- Insu are ductwork that runs through untreated areas in order to reduce condensation and lint buildup on duct surfaces.
- Incorrect or inadequate exhaust systems are not covered by the dryer warranty. Dryer failures or serv as required because of such exhaust systems will not be covered by the dryer warranty.
