Models rated at 4.8 kW and below at 240 V (4.2 kW and below at 208 V) require a separate 20 A circuit.
- A circuit breaker is recommended.
- Connect directly to the fused disconnect (or circuit breaker box) through flexible, armored or nonmetallic sheathed, copper cable (with grounding wire). See the "Make Electrical Connection" section.
- Flexible conduit from the oven should be connected directly to the junction box.
- Do not cut the conduit. The length of conduit provided is for serviceability of the oven.
- A UL listed or CSA approved conduit connector must be provided.

Water Supply Requirements

IMPORTANT:

- All installations must meet local plumbing code requirements.
- Connect to potable water supply only.
- There is not enough clearance to achieve a flush installation if a water shutoff valve is located in the wall behind the refrigerator.
- The water shutoff should be located in the base cabinet on either side of the refrigerator or some other easily accessible area. The right-hand side is recommended. The access hole through the cabinet must be within 1/2" (1.3 cm) of the rear

NOTE: If the water shutoff valve is in the back wall behind the refrigerator, it must be at an angle so that the tube is not kinked when the refrigerator is pushed into its final location.



- If the water shutoff valve is not in the cabinets, the plumbing for the water line can come through the floor. A 1/2" (12.7 mm) hole for plumbing should be drilled at least 6" (15.2 cm) from the right-hand or left-hand side cabinet or panel. Reverse Osmosis Water Supply
